Travel Highlights

Pinebrook's peaceful wooded setting is near Stroudsburg & East Stroudsburg, PA.

Approximate travel times:

- From Allentown or Scranton: 40 miles (less than 1 hour)
- From George Washington Bridge or Lincoln Tunnel: 80 miles (about 1.5 hours)
- From Philadelphia: 100 miles (about 2 hours)
- From Lancaster, PA: 110 miles (just over 2 hours)
